


### MEETINGS

The Luther League at Hegins meets on the Sunday we have Services at 7 p. m. and on the Friday after the Sunday Service at 7 p. m.

### HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS NO. 1

Articles of agreement between the congregations of the Pine Valley Parish of the Evangelical Lutheran Church: Friedens, Hegins; Christ, Fountain; St. Johns, Kimmels.

We, the undersigned members of Friedens, Christs, and St. Johns Congregations constituting the Church Councils of the said Congregations for ourselves and successors at a regular meeting held at Friedens Church at Hegins on the 2nd day of March 1912 A D., have adopted the following constitution.

- Art. 1 We unite to form a pastorate to be known as the "Pine Valley Parish of the Evangelical Lutheran Church" to consist of the Congregations named above.
- Art. 2 We recognize the Evangelical Lutheran Ministerium of Pennsylvania and Adjacent States as the Synod with which we harmonize in the Doctrine, Life, and Practice; and stand in official relation to the same.
- Art. 3 No Minister can become Pastor of the Parish unless he be a member of the said Synod or promised to become such at the earliest opportunity.
- Art. 4 In case the pastorate becomes vacant the secretary of the Parish shall call a joint meeting of the Church Councils, which meeting shall first be to open correspondence with the president of the district Conference asking his advice and guidance. No Congregation shall act independently of the rest.
- Art. 5 A Minister can become Pastor of the Parish only after being duly elected by the majority of the votes cast in the whole Parish according to the requirements of the constitution of the Congregations; and elections shall be held at the same time in all the Congregations. The Pastor shall officiate in all the Congregations as directed by the joint Council.
- Art. 6 As they who preach the Gospel live by the Gospel we agree unitedly and severally to support our Pastor to the best of our ability and faithfully reward him for the service; the amount to be raised as salary being left to the individual Congregations.

Art. 7 We will endeavor to maintain and advance the cause of the Evangelical Lutheran Church both in our midst and abroad and aid and defend it against all intrusion.

Art. 8 We will unite to elect and send a delegate with our pastor to Synod and Conference as often as they may meet; the delegate to be chosen from the Congregations in the following manner: First, Friedens; second, Christ; third, St. Johns; provided a Congregation fails to elect a delegate, it shall go to the next in order and so on.

Art. 9 We will endeavor to pay the expense of both the Pastor and delegate which will be in compliance with the Synodical resolutions adopted at Philadelphia, January 12, 1893.

Art. 10 The expense of the delegate shall not be paid unless said delegate make either a verbal or written report to the Congregations within two months after date of Synodical or Conference meeting.

Art. 11 The elders, deacons, and trustees shall assemble on the first Saturday in the year for the purpose of transacting all business of the Parish as well as discussing and acting upon all measures for the well being of the same. Said meeting shall be previously announced by the Pastor from each pulpit in the Parish; and a majority shall constitute a quorum.

Art. 12 The officers shall consist of a Secretary, a Treasurer and excepting the Pastor shall be anually elected at the regular meeting.

Art. 13 The Pastor (ex officio) shall preside at all meetings and open and close the same with prayer and benediction and in his report shall give evidence concerning the state of the Congregations and the Parish and may also call attention to any other matters of importance and interest.

Art. 14 The Secretary shall keep a correct roll of members, mark changes of officers in the different Congregations, make faithful record of all transactions of the meetings and in case of the absence of the Pastor or of his withdrawal for personal reasons, he shall call a meeting of the Councils constituting the Parish.

Art. 15 The Treasurer shall have charge of all funds, pay all bills as may be directed by the meeting and present an annual written report.

Art. 16 At each regular meeting an estimate of general expenses shall be made for the year and the same apportioned to the several congregations who shall as soon as possible raise their amounts and pay them into the hands of the Treas.

Art. 17 The above constitution can be amended or changed only on the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the voting members present.

As Pastor of the said (1) Hegins, Fountain, and Kimmels Church (es) you will be required to preach and teach the pure Word of God, to administer the Sacraments, and to maintain Christian discipline; to lead and direct the work of the Church in evangelizing, teaching and showing mercy; and to perform all other duties of the Gospel Ministry in accordance with the Confessions and Usages of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, and as becometh one called to that holy office.


In the name of the said (1) Hegins, Fountain, and Kimmels Evangelical Lutheran Churches we pledge you our prayers, our love and esteem and also our hearty co-operation in the work of the Lord, and for your temporal support and comfort we are authorized by the said (1) Hegins, Fountain, and Kimmels Church(es) to promise to pay you the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_ dollars annually in \_\_\_\_\_ monthly installments, together with the free use of the parsonage, (2) so long as you continue to be our pastor. (3)






THE PARSONAGE

Was Designed by the Intermediate Scholars of 1926, D. V. B. S.







FREIDEN'S **LUTHERAN AND** REFORMED CHURCH Hegins, Pa.


FREIDEN'S JUNIOR LEAGUE—ORGANIZED, JULY 17, 1926






ST. JOHN'S CHOIR—ORGANIZED 1928
